Self-Learning Aural Test App

[Ming Pao - Hong Kong, 12 Apr 2012] Students, who have taken foreign piano exams, know that in addition to playing piano, they must also take an aural test. However, few piano teachers know how to prepare their students for the aural test. Playnote Limited launched an app, available on both iPhones and iPads, that allows piano students to self-learn the skills necessary to prepare for the aural part of the Associated Board of Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) exam. The app includes a question database and a patented system that analyzes singing and clapping. It interacts with students in a real human voice. Using the app, piano students can self-learn aural skills any time, anywhere. The app can help students earn higher scores on the aural test. A Playnote Limited representative said the self-learning aural test app will be launched for other music examination authorities.
